Kayak Fishing and Spear Fishing Tournament
September 12 2009
Kayak Fishing Rules and Schedule**

1. Tournament is open to kayaks, paddleboards or any other human powered vessel only. **No motors of any kind allowed!**
2. **All money, after expenses will go to the American Cancer Society**
3. Jackpot money will be given for the three largest fish.
4. Only one fish will be weighed per angler. Other than for a SLAM (YT, WSB, Halibut)
5. Top Prizes will be awarded for the largest Yellowtail, Halibut, and Whites Seabass as well as to the winner of the Other division
6. \$500 Cash prize for the winner of each division.
7. **No Calico Bass, skates, rays, or sharks are eligible. Other than the Catch-Photo and release Calico bass division sponsored by KFAC. (see rules below)**
8. The "Other" division consists of any other fish not listed in the not eligible category (see rule #6), such as Bonita Barracuda, Sand Bass, Etc...(does not include second place fish in the YT, WSB or Halibut division)
9. The entry fee is per person **NOT** per kayak.
10. All anglers must have a valid California Fishing License.
11. All kayakers must carry a Coast Guard approved Personal Flotation Devices.
12. All anglers must follow the fishing regulations stated by the CA dept of Fish and Game
13. You must check in at the Boat launch at La Jolla Shores between 4:30am and 7:00am. **Before** fishing.
14. This is a shot gun start so **NO LAUNCHING Prior to 5:30 am or after 7:00**
15. The photos or video taken by the producers of this event will be the sole property of La Jolla Kayak Fishing and may be used to promote future events and sponsors products.
16. Largest single Fish by weight in the Yellowtail, White Seabass, Halibut and Other divisions wins \$500. Decisions on largest fish are final and at the sole discretion of La Jolla Kayak Fishing. In the event of a tie, we will flip a coin for placement.
17. Special prize for landing of the La Jolla Slam; Yellow tail, White Seabass, and Halibut. Heaviest slam wins.
18. **Only one top prize will be awarded per angler.** You can only win one division
19. Prizes will also be awarded for top female angler, top junior angler (under 16) any angler under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
20. \$5 per entry will go into a jackpot, which will be divided between the anglers with the three single largest fish. As an example this could be three large yellowtail, or two WSB and a Halibut.
21. All fish must be landed by rod and reel, unassisted. Only junior anglers may be assisted in landing of fish. (NO SPEARS) The use of a gaff is legal.
22. In the event no fish from a designated category is caught, the prize will go into the raffle. If it is a cash prize that money will be donated to the ACS.
23. **Pre-registration deadline is midnight August 31.**
24. **Enter before August 31, and you are eligible for hourly, on the water drawings for great prizes. Sponsored by OEX**

- 25. **Any deviation from the rules will be cause for disqualification.**
- 26. This event is rain or shine and there will be not refunds of entry money.
- 27. **Weigh-In Deadline is 1:30pm sharp!!!! AT Kate Sessions Park on Mt. Soledad** Give yourself plenty of time to get there.
- 28. **Please remember this event is for a good cause and is meant to be fun. Winning is not the important thing here, if we can help others and have a good time doing it.**

Kayak Fishing Assoc. of California, Calico Bass Catch-Photo and Release, division Rules.

- 1. This division is for Catch and release of **Calico Bass only**, no sand bass allowed, they can be used in the other division
- 2. A clear digital photo showing the entire fish must be taken and turned in at the weigh in. Pop the card out of your camera and we will load it into a laptop.
- 3. Photo must include the fish, on a tape measure, and the designated photo item which we will provide when you sign in. You must provide the measuring device.
- 4. The prize will go to the longest Calico bass, in the event of a tie the prize will go to the whoever weighs in first between the persons tied.
- 5. **Weigh-In Deadline is 1:30pm sharp!!!! At the South Shores Boat launch on Sea World Drive** Give yourself plenty of time to get there
- 6. Remember, this is an add-on event, free with your Moyer Memorial tournament entry. Go for big fish, go for bass, go for both - it's up to you.

Free Diving Spearfishing division Rules

- 1. Spear fisherman may swim from shore or use kayaks, paddleboards or any other human powered vessel only. **No motors of any kind allowed!**
- 2. **This is a breath hold free dive event only, no tanks allowed, no supplemental air of any kind**
- 3. Prizes will be given to the three divers with single largest fish by weight; only one fish will be weighed per person.
- 4. In the event of a tie the winner will be determined by a coin toss.
- 5. **The target species for this tournament are Yellowtail, White Seabass and Halibut, no other species of fish are eligible.**
- 6. All anglers must have a valid California Fishing License
- 7. You must check in at the Boat launch at La Jolla Shores between 4:30am and 7:00am. **Before** entering the water
- 8. Those using a kayak or paddle board to reach their diving area may not launch their kayak until 5:30am and may launch from La Jolla Shores or any other safe launch between PB point and Point La Jolla.
- 9. If going to a launch other than La Jolla shores you may not leave the registration area before 5:30 am
- 10. Those that will be diving from shore may start between PB point and Point La Jolla only but can not leave the La Jolla Shores registration area before 5:30 am.
- 11. If no fish are weighed the prize will go into the raffle or silent auction if cash the prize will be donated to the ACS.
- 12. **Pre-registration deadline is midnight August 31.**

13. **Enter before August 31, and you are eligible for hourly, on the water drawings for great prizes.**
14. **Any deviation from the rules will be cause for disqualification.**
15. This event is rain or shine and entry money will not be refunded.
16. All anglers must follow the fishing regulations stated by the CA dept of Fish and Game
17. **Weigh-In Deadline is 1:30pm sharp!!!! At Kate Sessions Park on Mt. Soledad Give yourself plenty of time to get there**
